A. Monthly Departmental Report

IV. <u>UNFINISHED AND OLD BUSINESS</u>

A. Update on Cedarock Park Equestrian Center

Brian Baker reported that the Department is requesting the use of Performance Management funds for this project. The matter will be considered by the Alamance County Board of Commissioners on March 7th.

B. Update on Alamance Wellness Collaborative Grant Application

The Commission considered the Department efforts to seek grant funds from Impact Alamance via the Alamance Wellness Collaborative Grant Process for the development of a trailhead and additional Haw River Trail trail near Valley Road in Graham. After discussion and upon the motion of Kelly Ronnow and the second of Lee Isley, the Commission voted unanimously to recommend approval of the application by the Alamance County Board of Commissioners.

C. Update on Theft of Property at Cedarock Park

Brian Baker reported that the Department is seeking funds from the Alamance County Board of Commissioners to replace the items lost to theft. The matter will be considered by the Alamance County Board of Commissioners on March 7th.

V. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

A. <u>Impact Alamance Grant Application - Saxapahaw Island</u>

Brian Baker reported that the Department is seeking grant funds from Impact Alamance for the development of a natural playground on Saxapahaw Island. After discussion and upon the motion of Eddie Boswell and the second of Kelly Ronnow, the Commission voted unanimously to recommend approval of the application by the Alamance County Board of Commissioners.

B. <u>FY2016-17 Budget Preparations – Commission Priorities</u>

The Commission discussed priorities for the Department with regard to the Department's request for funds for the FY2016-17 Budget. The Commission requested that additional funds be sought for marketing purposes and for the improvement of signage in and around Departmental facilities. No action was taken.

C. <u>Discussion of NRPA "Three Pillars" Messaging Strategy</u>

Discussion was held regarding the "Three Pillars" messaging strategy currently being promoted by the National Recreation and Parks Association. A brief video detailing the strategy was presented. No action was taken.
