B. <u>Update on Impact Alamance Grant Application - Saxapahaw Island</u>
Brian Baker reported that the Department was awarded \$100,000 in grant funds from
Impact Alamance for the development of a nature playground on Saxapahaw Island. The
acceptance of grant funds was approved by the Alamance County Board of

Commissioners. Completion of the playground is targeted for June 2017. No action was taken.

## C. <u>Update on Alston Quarter Property</u>

A report was given regarding the efforts of the County to research the possibility of acquiring the Alston Quarter property in southern Alamance County. The research is being conducted pursuant to a presentation by a member of the public at the March 21<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Board of Commissioners. No action was taken.

# A. Discussion of ACRPD Athletic Program

A discussion was held regarding the current status of the youth athletics program including a review of enrollment numbers across jurisdictions. No action was taken.
