The board discussed that if the option of accepting the museum facility as a gift were presented to the Alamance County Board of Commissioners, they would support the decision to accept the gift.  Nick Fortune, Parks Superintendent, presented information about the computer maintenance management software, Fixx. This new management software was implemented in spring 2019 and helps the department track expenses, plan workload and inform decisions.
